The TODOS Conferences Committee will review the proposals for the TODOS Strand and will notify you regarding your status for the strand by Friday, April 15. The TODOS Conferences Committee may suggest edits to your proposal to help clarify or strengthen your title and description. You may then access your proposal on the CMC-N website and make changes before April 30. Once your proposal has been selected for the TODOS strand, you may not change the type of session because of the types of slots allocated to us. The CMC-N Program Committee will schedule the chosen presentations.

If your proposal is not selected for the TODOS Strand, then it will still be considered by the CMC-N Program Committee for inclusion on the program. If you miss the TODOS strand deadline of April 1, 2016, you may still submit a proposal directly to CMC-N for general consideration by the Program Committee until April 30, 2016.

We hope to receive many excellent proposals for the TODOS strand so that we can offer very strong equity sessions to attendees. Please send your proposal in by **April 1, 2016.**
