Message From the TODOS President April 2023

Colleagues,

Last week I had the chance to attend a meeting with colleagues from around the world and learned about some teachings of the <u>Quechua people</u>, South American First Peoples, and their <u>language</u> / dialects.

One of the speakers at the meeting paraphrased some of the teachings in helping our collective to vision a future - the speaker shared that in Quechua, the word for "behind" is the same word as "future" and the phrase "in front" is the same as "in past." The image the speaker shared is that as humans, we walk through life backwards - since we, as humans, can 'see' our past, but the future is not yet known and not yet seen - therefore it is behind them. I found this fascinating article that offered me more insight into this image and framing.

This image is helping me to frame the writing for this month's e-news. This month marks the end of my first year as President of TODOS. It's been a busy 12 months, learning about the way this amazing volunteer - lead and run organization works, that is 'seeing' the past. 2023 is the 20th Anniversary of TODOS: Mathematics for ALL and it's given me the opportunity to learn more about the beginnings of the organization and more about the humans that made the commitment those years ago and up until today to supporting a mathematics education professional organization with a vision and mission focused on equity for ALL.
