## Session Descriptions

<b><u>Opening Keynote (45-60 minutes)</u></b>	
<b><u>Impact Sessions</u></b> <b>(2 hours with 30 minutes follow-up)</b>	Build a foundation for your conference experience by examining the theme of Advocating for Equity and Social Justice with attendance at one of six Impact Sessions. Each of these sessions is led by expert national speakers in the fields of mathematics and equity and will provide you with a framework for applying your focus for learning throughout the rest of the conference.
<b><u>Investigate Sessions</u></b> <b>(90 minutes)</b>	Deepen your understanding of different conference themes by exploring and participating in the different investigate sessions offering pragmatic strategies that will impact your specific setting. These sessions will be highly participatory, and you can expect abundant learning opportunities that explore implementation in many different contexts.
<b><u>Innovate Sessions</u></b> <b>(60 minutes)</b>	Experience innovative and effective ideas, strategies, or resources that will influence practice in PreK-12 classrooms, professional development settings for teachers or leaders, or teacher education programs.
<b><u>Imagine Sessions</u></b> <b>(40 minutes)</b>	Engage in the radical imagination of the possibilities for educational advocacy and justice with a short burst session showcasing research, projects, or innovations with connections to practice.
<b>Ignite TODOS</b>	Be inspired and engaged by this series of short, powerful presentations. Each ignite TODOS talk is exactly 20 slides in 15-second interval, insights are shared that generate awareness, stimulate thought and ignite action.
<b>Social Justice Panel</b>	In this panel, presenters will share their stories as teachers and scholars whose work offers alternatives for humanizing the learning experiences of our Latin@ children and their teachers. Their stories attest to the power of convivencia (togetherness) that has been taken away from our children's education.
<b>From Awareness to Action</b> <b>(Unstructured)</b>	Converse with speakers in an informal setting about how to take ideas and strategies you are learning to actionable approaches to advocate for equity and social justice in your specific setting.
<b>Zona Libre</b>	Relax in a safe and free space where you can chat and network with friends and colleagues, including authors of recent publications related to equity and social justice.
<b>Kay Gilliland Equity Workshop Series</b> <b>(60 minutes)</b>	Join the Presidents of mathematics education organizations in the Kay Gilliland Equity Dialogues. They will be dialoguing around efforts each organization is doing to advocating for equity and social justice. The series will be presented in honor of beloved Kay Gilliland whose career focused on the equity principles at the core of TODOS.
