# Achieving Excellence and Equity for Latino Students: Viewing Classrooms through Their Eyes

Join Kathryn Chval as she engages TODOS members in a unique professional development session aimed at enhancing curriculum, instruction, and assessment practices to facilitate the participation of Latinos in mathematics classrooms. Dr. Chval will share what she has learned from a study of Latino English Language Learners in which elementary students film their mathematics classrooms using head-mounted video cameras. Watching classroom interactions from the students' perspective has given Kathryn and the participating teachers new insights into how to support the learning of mathematics for Latinos.
